

Pennsylvania Lumber Museum Cork Camp

The Pennsylvania Lumber Museum's annual Cork Camp runs over two days, August 3rd and 4th. Campers will learn about the life of the 19th century loggers through various educational activities. Camp activities include log birling in the pond, (wood) hatchet throwing, camp cooking, and more! Registration includes admission to the Pennsylvania Lumber Museum's exhibits and a Sunday Pass to the Woodsman's Show at Cherry Spring State Park.

Daily Schedule:

Saturday, August 3: Please drop off your camper promptly at 9 AM at the Pennsylvania Lumber Museum. Campers should bring a bag lunch and water. Please pick up your camper at 8 PM.

Activities will include a hike on the sustainable forestry trail, a tour through the museum, and training in hatchet throwing, board drilling (the old fashioned way), log peeling, crosscut sawing (for real), cooking over fire, log birling, sunflower seed spitting contests, and (model) log raft racing.

Sunday, August 4: Please drop off your camper promptly at 9 AM at the Woodhick Grove at Cherry Springs State Park. Campers should bring a bag lunch and water. Please pick up your camper at 2 PM. Campers will present their skills in Woodhick Grove in the morning, then watch the semi-pro logger presentations in the arena.

What to bring and wear:

Dress comfortably! Hats, hiking boots, sunscreen, and insect repellent are all highly recommended. Please feel free to wear your own woodhick clothing. Swimming gear is required for Saturday.

Ages: Ten years and up. Families welcome.

Price: \$50/camper

Scholarships: Full scholarships are available to campers 18 and under. Write a 200-250 word essay about "Why I want to go to Cork Camp" and send it to palumbermuseum@gmail.com or mail the essay to the Lumber Museum by July 10. Scholarship recipients will be notified by July 11.
